## Heritage Village hosting photo contest

Contestants can pick up entry forms at Heritage Village or call 409-283-2272 with any questions. The entries can be mailed to the Village or delivered in person. All of the entries can be picked up beginning Oct. 19.

The organizers have stated to participants that the greatest care will be taken in handling every entry, however the Village is not responsible for any damage or loss that might occur with the entries.
